Please do **not** sweep leaves into the street or road. Leaves accumulate into catch basins and clog them creating drainage problems.



NOTE: If you have leaves that need to be picked up after the official Leaf Collection is over, please call the Highway Office at 860-446-4127 and leave your name, address, phone number and about how many bags of leaves you have and we will pick them up on a Wednesday. One week notice is required.

- → If a holiday falls on a Friday, and this is your pickup day, it will be picked up on Thursday morning*

*For Thanksgiving Day and the Day after Thanksgiving, if these are your pickup days, Thursday Thanksgiving Day will be picked up on Wednesday morning and Friday the Day-After Thanksgiving Day will be picked up on the following Monday morning.
