Registration Policy

Registration is required for all programs. If the class does not reach its minimum enrollment, it will be cancelled. The Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel any program. Participants will be notified of all cancellations. Full payment of fees on all activities and classes must be made at the time of registration. Checks are payable to the "City of Groton."

Refund Policy

If the Recreation Department cancels a program/class, a refund will be given. **Credit card convenience fees are non-refundable.** If a session is cancelled due to weather or other problems, an effort will be made to schedule a make-up session. If a make-up session cannot be scheduled, no partial refund will be made.

Cancellations

Program cancellations due to weather conditions will be announced on Channels 3, 4, 6 & 8, 105.5, 104.7, 102.3 FM & 980 AM, or the individual may call the Recreation Department at 446-4128. Evening activities will be cancelled by 3:00 pm.

Whenever Groton schools is cancelled or closed early, programs will be cancelled.

How do I purchase a Season Beach Pass:

Online Sales will be allowed May 1 — May 31 ONLY

Starting May 1st you can visit our website at http://cityofgroton.recdesk.com, click on Programs then Beach Pass.

You must login with your User Name/Password or create a New Account before starting this process. \$1.00 has been added on to each Beach Pass price to cover mailing and postage.

Uploading of your car registration and ID is required and beach pass will me mailed to you.

Please be sure we have your correct address for mailing.

After May 31st Online Registration will no longer be available.

Drop Box or Mail In will be available starting May 1st throughout the remainder of the summer (ends 9/3/21) to drop off all your necessary documents (copy of car registration and photo ID) and beach pass fee for processing. The Drop Box is the big blue box at the top of the landing of the City Municipal Building.

You must include a self-addressed stamped envelope OR add \$1.00 to the fee to cover mailing. Please be sure we have your <u>correct address for mailing</u>. Checks made out to: City of Groton Mail In, please address as: City of Groton Parks & Recreation, 295 Meridian Street, Groton CT 06340

<u>Acceptable documents to obtain a Season Beach Pass</u>: Current car registration of the car that the pass will go on, ID (driver's license) must match name on that registration. If you are a city taxpayer or have just moved to the City of Groton <u>but registration does not show a City address</u> you can show a current tax bill, utility bill, lease or deed to prove residency.
