Registration Policy

Registration is required for all programs. If the class does not reach its minimum enrollment, it will be cancelled. The Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel any program. Participants will be notified of all cancellations. Full payment of fees on all activities and classes must be made at the time of registration. Checks are payable to the "City of Groton."

Refund Policy

If the Recreation Department cancels a program/ class, a refund will be given. **Credit card convenience fees are non-refundable.** If a session is cancelled due to weather or other problems, an effort will be made to schedule a make-up session. If a make-up session cannot be scheduled, no partial refund will be made.

Cancellations

Program cancellations due to weather conditions will be announced on Channels 3, 4, 6 & 8, 105.5, 104.7, 102.3 FM & 980 AM, or the individual may call the Recreation Department at 860-446-4128. Evening activities will be cancelled by 3:00 pm.

How do I purchase a Season Beach Pass:

Drop Box on Mail In will be available starting May 1st throughout the remainder

of the summer (ends 9/1/22). Drop off/mail in all necessary documents: copy of car registration, photo ID, legal sized self-addressed stamped envelope and beach pass fee. Pass will be mailed back to you. The Drop Box is the big blue box at the top of the landing of the City Municipal Building. You must include a #10 sized self-addressed stamped envelope OR add \$1.00 to the fee to cover mailing. Please be sure we have your correct address for mailing. Checks made out to: City of Groton. Mail In, please address as: City of Groton Parks & Recreation, 295 Meridian Street, Groton CT 06340. Process may take up to a week.

In Person Sales will begin on Saturday, May 7, 2022 from 9 am—2 pm.

Acceptable documents to obtain a Season Beach Pass:

Current car registration of the car that the pass will go on, ID (driver's license) must match name on that registration. If you are a city taxpayer or have just moved to the City of Groton <u>but registration does not show a City address</u> you can show a current tax bill, utility bill, lease or deed to prove residency.



Spring Leaf Collection:

Wednesdays, April 20 & 27, May 4, 11, 18, 25, 2022

LEAVES WILL NOT BE COLLECTED IF PLACED IN PLASTIC BAGS.

NOTE: If you have leaves that need to be picked up after the official Leaf Collection is over, please call the Highway Office at 860-446-4127 and leave your name, address, phone number and about how many bags of leaves you have and we will pick them up on a Wednesday. One week notice is required.

Please do **not** sweep your leaves into the street or road. Leaves accumulate into the catch basins and clog them up creating drainage problems.

- → If a holiday falls on a Friday, and this is your pickup day, it will be picked up on Thursday morning.
